

Loan costs Nationaal Museum van Wereldculturen (NMVW)_2020

Loan fee

A loan fee will be charged in the case of commercial parties requesting loans.

Rates (all prices are exclusive of V.A.T.)

If carried out by NMVW, fees will be charged in accordance with the following rates:

1. Conservation treatment (if more than half an hour per object) **€ 80 per hour**

Costs for treating an object are calculated according to the actual duration of the treatment, including 30 minutes for writing up the treatment documentation. Materials are included in this hourly rate. The price may be higher when a freelance conservator charging a higher hourly rate is used, when an extensive conservation treatment is necessary or if it is necessary to use unusual or expensive materials.

2. Support making **€ 70 per hour**
excl. cost of materials

3. Mounting and framing of prints and drawings **€ 70 per hour**
excl. cost of materials

4. Standard object packaging **€ 195 per package**
(up to 50 x 50 x 50 cm; max. 5 hours labour)

5. Transport crate

- Transport crate; new **(via transport agent)**
- Transport crate; reused **€ 275 per crate**

6. Courier costs

A minimum of two days and one night is stipulated for European loans. For intercontinental loans, a minimum stay of three days and two nights is required, dependent on time of arrival.

Courier expenses, to be arranged by and paid directly by the Borrower, include:

- Travel expenses **cost price**
- Accommodation incl. breakfast **cost price**
- Per diem

The Borrower should pay the per diem allowance in cash directly to the courier on arrival. It is expected that the per diem will be sufficient for expenses incurred for meals and local transport (inclusive to/from airport).

When the courier accompanies the loan during (intercontinental) transport, the courier should travel either First or Business class.

7. Interim checks and exchange of objects

In the case of long term loans, objects that are light and/or climate-sensitive might be subject to rotation after a certain period of time. If applicable, this will be agreed in advance with the Borrower and the costs involved will be charged to the Borrower on the basis of the above-mentioned price list, including costs for couriers and any necessary materials (mounts, supports, packaging etc.). The NMVW reserves the right to check the conditions of the loan or the loaned objects at any time during the loan period, in so far as this might be considered reasonable and in agreement with the Borrower.

8. Insurance

For all borrowers outside the Netherlands, in discussion and agreement with the NMVW, the Borrower will insure the Loan for the full loan period under an "all risk" nail to nail insurance policy. NMVW may approve coverage by state indemnity. In order to require approval, please send the conditions of the indemnity scheme to our registrar. If the NMVW does not agree to the conditions set out in the insurance policy of the borrower, the NMVW will insure the Loan through their own insurance company and the costs thereof will be invoiced to the Borrower.
